

# A MODD Installation Support Note for European Users

## If the installer quits because it won't recognize your version of Office:

If your Windows regional and language options use European settings, please take one additional quick step before starting to install MODD. This step will temporarily change a Windows regional option default. You can change it back at any time after installation:

- Prior to installation, select Regional and Language Options from the Windows Control Panel. Then, click Customize on the Regional Options tab of the dialog box that opens. This will open the Customize Regional Options dialog box.

**Note:** If viewing Control Panel in Category View, select Date, Time, Language and Regional Options to see Regional and Language Options.

- On the Numbers tab of the Customize Regional Options dialog box, set a **period** as the **Decimal Symbol** and a **comma** as the **Digit Grouping Symbol**. Then, click OK twice to accept your changes and close all open dialog boxes.
- You can now follow the installation instructions as they appear on the MODD CD or in Chapter 00 of the MODD Design Guide.

**Important:** You can reset your preferred regional and language option defaults at any time after installation completes. Once installed, there is nothing in MODD that conflicts with European numeric notation.
